TERMS AND CONDITIONS FOR MICHE WARRANTY EXTENSION 2+2 YEARS

We are glad to offer this further benefit to all Miche carbon fibre wheels owners. You can get an additional 2 years of warranty, in addition to the 2 years foreseen by law, today and at no cost.

Before to proceed, we ask you to carefully read the conditions that must necessarily be fulfilled in order to be eligible for the 2-year warranty extension:

Warranty extension to Miche carbon fibre wheels is valid for all wheels purchased after July 1st 2024.

The 24-month warranty extension (in addition to the 24-month legal warranty) on Miche carbon fiber wheels is valid only for the first purchaser of the wheels. The extension, therefore, cannot be applied on the purchase of used or second-hand wheels.

The warranty extension can be activated by registering the wheels at <u>www.miche.it</u> in the proper section by entirely filling in the registration form within 30 days from the date of the first purchase.

The essential data that must be reported are: buyer personal data (as requested in the form), serial number "MQC code" **of each individual wheel**, receipt (or proof) of purchase.

Warranty, both the ordinary legal 24-month warranty and the extension of additional 24 months, does not cover damages caused by:

- improper assembly and installation and/or not in accordance with the instruction manual
- accident, neglect, other abnormal, excessive, or improper use, improper repair
- modifications, repairs, or use with incompatible or non-original parts
- exceeding the maximum system weight indicated for the wheel model
- failure to maintain as prescribed and indicated in the written instructions provided with the product
- corrosion of one (or more) wheel parts and components
- cleaning and washing performed with high-pressure jets and/or aggressive detergents or products

Wear and tear are not covered by warranty.

Wear and tear is defined as damage that occurs naturally and inevitably as a result of normal use and of the product life cycle.

Below is an illustrative, but not exhaustive, list of parts typically subject to wear and tear and not covered by warranty:

- freehub body, spring, pawls and ratchet ring
- spokes
- ball bearings
- tubeless tape
- rim braking area and brake pads
- wear and tear related to mechanical fatigue of materials during the life and use of the product
